As cancer cells grow, they release circulating tumor DNA (ctDNA) into the urine and blood. The Trovera liquid biopsy test utilizes urine (and blood) to provide you and your physician with a continuous stream of information about changes in your cancer.



IDENTIFY

Trovera identifies the presence or absence of a genetic mutation



INFORM

Trovera provides you and your physician with information that can aid in decision making regarding treatment and management of your cancer



MONITOR

Trovera monitors changes in your cancer, including if your cancer is responding to treatment, or if your cancer is progressing

- ▶ Could a Trovera test provide information about how my cancer is doing between scheduled exams?
